### **Event 1 - International Conference "Civil Society Sustainability in New EU Member States and the Role of EU Funds"**

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to consider how much EU funds have contributed to the sustainability of civil society, such as the status of civil society in candidate countries and potential candidates for EU membership, as the governments of these countries prepare for decentralization of EU funds during the pre-accession period, which is a good practice to apply. which should be avoided, talk about the success of the use of pre-accession funds in Croatia, and the structure of the structural funds management system in Croatia, the difficulties encountered in the initial period of their implementation, the way this affects the end users and the very purpose of these funds.

### **Event 2 - Refugee Media Reporting - Lectures at the Faculty of Political Science Zagreb**

**Participation:** The event involved 60 citizens, including 35 participants from the city of Zagreb (**Croatia**), including 3 participants from the city of Split (**Croatia**).

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Zagreb, Croatia, 17/04/2018

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to "portray" refugees and migrants within professional ethics and journalistic profession, encourage public discussion among citizens, especially young student populations, about important value determinations that could challenge positive democratic reforms, especially in times of refugee crisis. Encouraging intercultural dialogue, suppression of intolerance, xenophobia, prejudice ...

### **Event 3 - En Face :: Anfas - Award Ceremony in Zagreb**

**Participation:** The event involved 750 citizens, including 20 participants from the city of Zagreb (**Croatia**) 10 participants from the city of Split (**Croatia**).

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Zagreb, Croatia, 05/05/2018.

**Short description:** The aim of the event was affirming and promoting the actions of those individuals who have indebted us and inspired us to resist socially retrograde phenomena and concepts.

### **Event 4 - Three Guineas, theater play**

By practical work, the participants had the opportunity to become acquainted with the entire screen-printing process and to create some other motives on their own.

The winners of numerous Vogue competitions have performed a program consisting of three parts: a panel in which they presented a vogue or ballroom culture, dance workshops where interested participants learned the basic elements of various fashion styles and evening competitions.

All people of good will are invited to support the right of individuals to self-determination and their choice of life, even when it does not fit into the established social norms.
